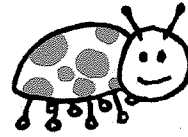


Bright Futures

Bright Futures is a community-based program designed to meet the needs of families with young children.

Who does Bright Futures serve?

Bright Futures serves all families, with children under 5 years old, living in the Intermountain area.

What services does Bright Futures provide?

- Playgroups for infants and toddlers
- Parenting education
- Health and nutrition information
- Physical activity programs
- Hearing, and vision screenings
- Developmental screenings
- Monthly newsletters
- Resource and referral services for parents, caregivers, healthcare providers, businesses, schools, and community organizers.
- Breastfeeding support
